All Students (6th-12th Grades)

Personal Note-Taking System

Students will be responsible to take and keep class notes in several different subjects (primarily history, science, and English classes). You may choose the most effective system for your student. Here are a few ideas that have been used well by GCA students:

- A single 5-subject notebook (needs to be rather large to last the entire year)
- A one-subject notebook for each class (the large notebooks with pockets in the front have worked best)
- A three ring binder with folders and dividers so that notes for each class may be kept and filed on loose-leaf paper
- A combination of the above (one-subject notebooks for certain subjects, folders and loose-leaf paper for others)
- High School students (9th-12th grades) may use personal electronic devices for academic purposes and may bring their own tablets or notebook computers to school (cell phones not permitted). This is not a requirement but is an option you may consider. All high school students will have access to the school computer lab for academic purposes (research, writing/printing school papers, etc.)

GCA teachers will NOT allow students to simply write notes on notebook paper then stuff it in their textbooks.

Choose the system that works for your student. The goal is to make sure your student always has the materials available to take notes and an easy system to keep and locate them for future reference (see Personal Filing System below).

Personal Filing System

Throughout the year, students will be responsible for various papers in each class (review sheets, class notes, graded quizzes, etc.) that they will need to keep organized and available for review. GCA does not specify a specific filing system, but hopes that each student will find a system that works individually. Here are a few examples of filing systems that have worked for GCA students in the past:

- A three ring binder with dividers and folders for each subject
- Color-coded pocket folders for each subject
- Accordion filing folders
- Five-subject notebook with pockets

Classroom Supplies

Each student should bring the following expendable classroom supplies:

- 1 box of tissues
- 1 canister of disinfecting wipes (Clorox Disinfecting Wipes, Lysol Disinfecting Wipes, etc.)
